On March 16, 2006, the Vermont Public Service Board ("Board" or "PSB") issued an Order and Certificate of Public Good ("CPG") approving the Lamoille County 115 kV Project (the "Project") as proposed by Vermont Transco, LLC, Green Mountain Power Corporation and the Town of Stowe Electric Department (the "Petitioners").
