PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM
AND SCHEDULE

On November 8, 2007, Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc. and Vermont Transco, LLC (collectively, "VELCO") and Central Vermont Public Service Corporation ("CVPS") filed a petition with the Public Service Board ("Board") seeking a certificate of public good, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248, for the construction of a new 51-mile 345 kV transmission line from Vernon to Cavendish, new substations in Vernon and Newfane, a new one-mile 345 kV transmission line loop between the new Newfane substation and the new Vernon-Cavendish 345 kV line, and additional equipment at the Coolidge substation.

The Board convened a prehearing conference on December 19, 2007. The following parties entered appearances: Kimberly Hayden, Esq., of Downs Rachlin Martin, PLLC, for VELCO; James Porter, Esq. and Laura Beliveau, Esq., for the Vermont Department of Public Service ("Department"); David Englander, Esq., for the Agency of Natural Resources ("ANR"); Morris Silver, Esq., for CVPS. In addition to these parties, a number of other organizations and individuals attended the prehearing conference; several of these additional entities indicated that they might seek to intervene in this proceeding.¹

1. Carl Ferenbach, III and Judy W. Ferenbach, who were represented at the prehearing conference by George T. McNaughton, Esq., have already filed a motion to intervene.
