Re: Joint Petition of Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc., and Vermont Transco LLC (collectively known as VELCO) and Village of Lyndonville Electric Department (LED) for a Certificate of Public Good pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248 authorizing the construction of a Substation in the Town of Lyndon, Vermont

Dear Project Neighbor:

We want to make sure you are aware that on September 1, 2009, VELCO and LED (Petitioners) filed with the Vermont Public Service Board a petition, testimony and exhibits requesting that the Board issue a Certificate of Public Good (CPG) pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248(a), authorizing the Petitioners to construct the so-called Lyndonville Substation (the "Project"). The Project is designed to enhance the electric transmission system's reliability under present and future load levels and to increase the system's capacity to provide adequate electric supply to meet present and forecasted demand during all conditions, including those of equipment maintenance and failure.

A copy of the September 1st filing letter is attached. This letter has been sent to you because our records indicate that you are an owner of property located adjacent to the Project. If this is incorrect, please notify me at 1-802-770-6319. Persons who believe they have an interest that may be affected by the outcome of the proceeding can seek to formally become a party to the case under the Board's rules. The Board will set a deadline by which such requests must be received. This process is explained in the Public Service Board publication *Citizens Guide to the Vermont Public Service Board's Section 248 Process* which is available on the Board's website at <http://psb.vermont.gov/statutesrulesandguidelines/guidelines#248> or you may contact the Board for more information.

The Public Service Board will hold one or more public meetings at which members of the public will be invited to express their views concerning the Project. Newspaper notices of those public hearings will be provided several weeks in advance. You can also obtain the schedule of public hearings, once they are set, on the Public Service Board's website at <http://psb.vermont.gov/event> or by calling the Board at 802-828-2358.


In addition to public hearings, the Board will convene technical evidentiary hearings on the Project. Persons who demonstrate a substantial interest that may be affected by the outcome of the proceeding may seek formally to become a party to the case. The Board will set a deadline by which such requests must be made. You may contact the Board or the Department of Public Service for more information. If you wish, you may also share your views concerning the Project with the Vermont Department of Public Service, which acts as the public advocate in proceedings before the Board.
