The Northwest Regional Planning Commission received information regarding VELCO’s future request for approval pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §248 for the PV-20 Submarine Cable Replacement Project located in Grand Isle, Vermont.

NRPC’s Policy/Project Review Committee has reviewed the project description, testimonies, exhibits and documents included with the pre-filing application and have found that the proposed project does not conflict with the Northwest Regional Plan. However, the NRPC would like further reassurance from the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources regarding the proposed project’s compliance with Vermont Water Quality Standards. This may include an agreement between the two parties to design a Water Quality Monitoring Program specific to the project.
