STATEMENT OF NOTICE REQUIRED

Pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248(j)(2), Vermont Transco LLC and Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc. (collectively, "VELCO"), hereby provides the Public Utility Commission ("Commission") with a proposed written notice for the Commission to utilize to give written notice of the proposed certificate and its determination that the filing is complete to those parties specified in subdivision (a)(4)(C) of 30 V.S.A. § 248, to any public interest organization that has in writing requested notice of applications to proceed under this subsection, and to any other person found by the Commission to have a substantial interest in the matter. As required by Section 248(j)(2), such notice shall be published on the Commission's website and shall request comment within 30 days of the date of service of the complete filing on the question of whether the petition raises a significant issue with respect to the substantive criteria of Section 248.
