

Station service description



- Station service is usually located off substation end bus.
- Meter is read by VELCO during substation inspection and entered in Cascade.

Different payment considerations

- 115kV station service
 - VELCO pays use tax to state of VT.
 - Station service is allocated to losses.
- 13/34/46kV station service
 - DU installs revenue meter and reads station service use.
 - VELCO pays station service charges.
 - Station service costs are allocated PTF/Non PTF.

Station service inventory

- Inventory:
 - 35 meters that should be read by DUs. (32 locations)
 - (Barre~\$30/month) ($35 * \$30 * 12 = \$12,600$ year)
 - 37 meters that VELCO will pay use tax to the state of Vermont.
